WHEATON HALL stalked the pace off the rail, bid alongside a rival to gain the lead past midstretch and held gamely between foes late under urging. JUSTCRUISE stalked the pace inside, came out past midstretch and finished willingly three deep on the line. CAPT. JOE BLOW sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then angled in on the turn, fought back along the fence in the stretch and also went on well to the end. SUNSHINE RIDGE allowed to settle off the rail, went three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. ROGUE SCHOLAR chased between horses then three deep, continued outside a rival into and on the turn, came out three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAKE MINE VODKA settled off the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch and was not a threat. BRINSON chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, swung out into the stretch and weakened.
