Footnotes

RUNWAY ROSIE stalked the pace inside, swung three deep into the stretch and rallied between horses under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved narrowly best. LAVENDER SKY broke in and bumped a rival, settled off the rail, came out six wide into the stretch and finished well. ANGEL EYED had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, came back between foes past midstretch and bested the rest. JUMP ROPE GIRL dueled off the rail then inside down the hill, inched away in the stretch and weakened some late. POLO LOUNGE settled inside, went around a rival in midstretch, came out for room past midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. KISSIN PARTY bumped at the start, chased between horses, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SMOOCH stalked outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the hill, drifted five wide into the stretch and weakened. ALI MAC stalked outside a rival, split foes then angled in on the hill and also weakened in the stretch. ISLAND HOP cut the corner at the right hand curve, angled in and stalked outside a rival, dropped back in the stretch and had little left. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
