IDIDN'TDOANYTHING forced the pace between horses early], stalked off the rail, re-bid between foes into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and proved best under some urging. EXTREME NOTICE had speed three deep then stalked outside the winner, also re-bid three deep into the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but held second. BESTDRESSED stalked outside a rival then off the rail into the stretch and split horses late for the show. CAYAMBE took the early lead and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail into the stretch and until just past midstretch and weakened. ROOSEVELT chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PIRATES DEPUTY settled inside chasing the pace, dropped back along the rail on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
