JILL'S SKY had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the second turn, responded to some urging in the stretch and gamely held sway. ELEMENT K. chased inside then outside a rival into the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch and rallied late for second. STORMIN LUCY saved ground stalking the pace, remained inside in the stretch and edged a rival late for third. HONOR SPIRIT close up tracking the winner outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was edged late between horses for the show. CLEVER JUNE forced the pace outside the winner, stalked that one a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. BANISH THE BLUES three deep early, stalked off the rail, went three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
