Footnotes

TINA'S LOVE stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch and proved best under some urging and steady handling late. SONG SUNG GOLD tracked the pace a bit off the rail then inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and between horses into the stretch and held second. LA CHOLA bobbed at the start, went three deep into the first turn then chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival three wide at the wire for third. JANZIG MOON prompted the early pace inside then stalked along the rail, went around a rival in the stretch and was edged for the show inside. LADY'S CAPER dueled outside a rival then inched clear and angled in on the backstretch, set the pace inside but weakened in the stretch. BLUE CAY chased three deep then outside a rival, dropped back off the rail on the second turn and also weakened.
