Footnotes

JUNGLE GIRL between horses early, pressed the pace inside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, re-bid outside that one on the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. JUSTICE IS BRIEF had speed outside the winner then inched away and angled in leaving the first turn, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn, fought back inside through the stretch and continued willingly to the end. GULA GOLD unhurried a bit off the rail early, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. LADY ELIZABETH chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HELLO BOLLY saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and could not offer the necessary late response. ONIDA (IRE) stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn and could not offer the needed rally. MEAN HEAT a bit slow to begin, went four wide into the first turn then stalked three deep to the stretch and did not rally. LIKELY A STAR chased a bit off the rail then inside and weakened in the stretch. LITTLE MISS WIZZY (GB) rank early, went three deep into the first turn then chased between foes, continued outside a rival leaving the second turn and lacked a further response.
