Footnotes

CUPID'S KITTY had good early speed and dueled between horses, took a short lead into the stretch, fought back off the rail in midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. ALMACITA prompted the pace three deep between horses, battled outside the winner in midstretch, could not match that one late and just held second. TUSCAN PRINCESS a bit slow to begin, was taken outside a rival early to chase the pace, moved up some on the turn, split rivals in midstretch, drifted in and just missed the place. LET'S EAT OUT broke a bit slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, also split rivals in midstretch then drifted in and lacked the needed late kick. POINT REYNA went up four wide to force the pace to the stretch and weakened. FORGIVEANDFORGET settled three deep then outside a rival, continued just off the rail on the turn and did not rally. MADAME KIAWAH angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. DINNER AND A DANCE between foes early, dropped back a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and was done early.
