Footnotes

RANGER HEARTLEY broke outward and threw his head at the start, pulled his way to the lead outside rivals, angled in and set the pace inside, opened up on the backstretch, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, maintained the advantage under a mild hand ride in midstretch and drew off without further encouragement. SHOW THE FLAG between foes early, angled in and chased inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and was second best. LITECORR pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and held third. ZEES ECHO unhurried a bit off the rail then inside to the second turn, came out on that bend and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. SIBERIAN HEART hopped at the start, went four wide into the first turn then stalked outside a rival or just off the rail, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. SWISS EXPLOIT settled between foes then chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
