Footnotes

CORK CREEK between horses early, chased outside a rival then angled in early on the turn, split rivals leaving the turn and rallied under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and won clear. BARBARIC sped between foes to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth and just held second. ELUSIVE DESTINY bobbled at the start, pulled some and chased inside, steadied in tight early on the turn, came out on the bend and four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. PEMBA AT U. T. K. sent inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and lacked a late response. SAKE BOMB broke in and bumped a rival then bobbled a bit, settled outside then off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. JOYS LAST ONE stalked between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the turn and weakened. NU POWER bumped at the start, stalked three deep then outside a rival, dropped back leaving the turn and into the stretch and gave way. A claim of foul by the rider of ELUSIVE DESTINY against the winner for alleged interference into the turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to establish blame for the trouble to the former.
