Footnotes

DILEMMA saved ground chasing the pace, split horses leaving the turn, angled back to the inside into the stretch, rallied along the rail under some urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and drew clear. CAPED FOR FLIGHT sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out a bit into the stretch, could not hold off the winner but was clearly second best. PRIME RULER was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MR. NEGOTIATOR chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. HURRY UP AUSTIN stalked the pace between foes then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn and weakened. CONCLAVE angled in and tracked the leader inside then a bit off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and also weakened.
