Footnotes

CAUSE pulled a bit between horses chasing the early pace, continued a bit off the rail, found the fence into the stretch, bid a bit off the rail past midstretch to gain the lead and proved best under urging. QUITE THE MAN also pulled between horses then stalked just off the inside, bid three deep past midstretch and continued willingly. MONOMONAC PLAYBOY saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside in the stretch and bested the others. ROLLIN N' TUMBLIN had speed wide early, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back past midstretch and weakened late. LA MINSTRAL broke

slowly, settled inside then off the rail, came six wide into the stretch and improved position. GO ALL IN settled inside chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BUILT FOR THEDERBY stalked three deep then between horses leaving the backstretch, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S CAT TIME settled inside, saved ground throughout to no avail. NU POWER TWO chased between horses then off the rail, came out five wide into the stretch and did not rally. BLACK MAGIC angled in and chased three deep, went up four wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. RUNINFROMTHEDEPUTY four wide into the first turn, chased between horses then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and had little left for the stretch.
