FIERY REBEL had speed outside a rival then stalked off the rail, bid alongside that one into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away under urging in midstretch and held on gamely. JUST HEAT stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, bid along the fence past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. HOLD THIS wide early, stalked outside then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also went on willingly outside the top pair late. WAAFI wide between foes early, stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and was outfinished. BRIAN THE BOLD settled inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and improved position. SAINT CHOCOLATE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued inside on the turn, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ABSOLUTE COURAGE bobbed at the start, went up outside to chase the pace, continued three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. REMUS a bit slow to begin, settled between foes then outside a rival on the turn, came out and waited off heels three deep into the stretch, came out again for room in midstretch and lacked the needed response. SAGAPONACK chased outside, went four wide into and on the turn and five wide into the stretch and did not rally. EDDIE THE HAT lugged out while taking the early lead, dueled off the rail then inched away, angled in some for the turn, was between foes in midstretch and weakened. TACTICAL TALENT chased between horses, dropped back and angled in on the turn, drifted in from the whip and hit the rail in

upper stretch and had little left for the drive.
