TORO TRIPPI broke in a bit, had speed outside foes then inched away and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail and remained clear under urging. FERRANDERO stalked outside a rival, continued off the rail in the stretch and was clearly second best. DALTON GANG saved ground tracking the winner, came off the inside in the stretch and bested the others. BOSTON BAKED BEAN settled between foes then outside a rival, split horses into the stretch and was not a threat. EL CHAPO stalked outside then off the rail, angled in and fell back on the turn, found the fence in the stretch and lacked a further response. UNUSUAL D J dropped back between foes then outside a rival, was off the rail on the turn and three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. FLASHY MAN angled in and saved ground to no avail. LITTLE BITE fell back between foes after the start, angled in on the backstretch to save ground off the pace and was outrun.
