BERT'S LAW had speed outside a rival then angled in approaching the first turn and dueled inside, regained the advantage into the second turn, inched away a quarter mile out, came off the rail into the stretch, angled back in and kicked clear and held under left handed urging. FIRE BREAK chased between horses then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch, was three deep past midstretch and edged a foe for second between rivals late. BLAZING SPIRIT settled inside, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just missed the place. DYNAMIC RANGE stalked three deep, angled to the inside on the second turn, came out a bit in the stretch and was outfinished late for a minor award. SHELTER ISLAND a bit slow to begin, settled off the pace inside, split horses into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. NITRO ACTIVE had speed inside then dueled outside the winner, gained a short advantage on the backstretch, battled alongside that one on the second turn, was between horses past midstretch and weakened. UNBRIDLED PAPILLON was in a good position chasing the pace inside, fell back some on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
