GERONIMO (CHI) settled outside a rival chasing the pace, angled in leaving the hill, came out in upper stretch and responded to left handed urging to surge four wide between horses late and get the nod. KING ROBYN sped to the early lead then stalked a bit off the rail, came out some in the stretch, gained a short lead outside a foe in deep stretch and was caught between rivals at the wire. JUNGLE PRINCE chased outside then alongside a rival, came out leaving the hill and six wide into the stretch and closed willingly. COURAGEOUS KING off a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and finished well between horses late. MIGHTY BEAU went up inside to gain the lead, set the pace inside, opened up down the hill and held well but was overtaken late. ROYAL PLACE chased inside, came out leaving the hill and three deep into the stretch and was outfinished. TSIGANE (FR) had good speed four wide after the right hand curve, stalked outside on the hill, came out five wide into the stretch and weakened. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS had speed between foes then stalked outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. Rail on hill at 7 feet.
