Footnotes

NANCYLAND stalked off the rail or between horses leaving the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, took the lead, kicked clear and held under urging. POWERFUL SISTER chased between horses then off the rail, split rivals into the stretch and finished well. HALO MS. LION dueled between horses then stalked off the rail, came out into the stretch, re-bid between foes in midstretch and bested the rest. LEMME FREE chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ST. AMAND went up inside to duel for the lead, inched clear on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SEATTLE SWEET allowed to settle off the rail, angled

in some leaving the backstretch, came out a bit in the stretch and was not a threat. THRILLOFALIFETIME forced the pace three deep on the backstretch, angled in and stalked on the turn and weakened in the stretch. MARILYN'S SUMMER unhurried early, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. GLACIER STORM slowly into stride, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a factor. STORM CAPER stalked outside then three deep leaving the backstretch and again into the stretch and weakened. BON BON BONNIE saved ground tracking the pace, dropped back past midway on the turn and also weakened. WE CHANCE IT broke slowly, drifted out while climbing when off the rail on the backstretch, raced greenly and was outrun.
