Footnotes

OVERLY TEMPTING dueled outside a rival, inched away into the stretch and drew off under a steady hand ride. KALAMATA stalked the pace off the rail, angled in outside a rival into the stretch and gained the place. UNBRIDLED TROUBLE went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch but held third. SILVERS SURPRISE dropped back off the rail early, went five wide into the turn and four wide on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRULY QUIET chased between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. LATTE stalked four wide on the backstretch and three deep between foes on the turn and also weakened. KOKOPELLI TRAIL chased the dueling leaders between horses then inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch. TRANSCENDING saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and into the stretch and gave way.
