Footnotes

UNCLE JEEP dueled inside, was shuffled back from tight quarters into the turn, came out on the bend and three deep into the stretch, bid again outside foes in midstretch, gained the lead under left handed urging in deep stretch and held gamely between foes late. MR. MONKEY JONES chased between horses then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and went willingly to the wire outside foes late to just miss. BLACK KETTLE settled three deep then off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch, cut to the inside in midstretch and finished with interest inside. CUT THE CHECK dueled between horses then inside on the turn, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch, was between foes again past midstretch and was outfinished. FINAL JOURNEY stalked inside then a bit off the rail, came out for room in midstretch and could not quite summon the necessary response. AQUICKSTING dueled three deep then outside a rival, put a head in front between horses in midstretch and weakened late.
