MY SUMMER SLEW sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, kicked clear on the hill and held on gamely under left handed urging. CLEISTHENES a bit slow to begin, pulled his way along off the rail then moved up three deep on the hill, continued outside a rival, came out in the stretch and finished well. MOBILIZED allowed to settle outside then off the rail, continued alongside a rival on the hill, swung out four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. FU PEG HE RAT chased between horses then outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DIFERENTKINDAGREAT pulled his way along to stalk the pace off the rail then inside on the hill, split horses in midstretch and could not summon the necessary response. TEMERITY broke inward and slowly, settled inside, came out leaving the hill and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. GANDOLF chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the hill and into the stretch and weakened. KANAN DUME stalked inside, steadied in tight leaving the hill and did not rally. CAPTAIN STEEL broke inward, pulled his way along off the rail then stalked three deep, continued off the inside leaving the hill, angled in nearing the stretch and weakened in the drive. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
