FORD ISLAND had good early speed off the rail then dueled between horses, battled outside a rival leaving the turn, inched away into the stretch, found the rail and won clear under left handed urging. WARREN'S BLVD. prompted the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, came out in upper stretch and just held second. UNBROKEN VOW chased a bit off the rail or inside, found the fence again into the stretch and just missed the place. PROFESSNL COURTESY a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail chasing the pace and lacked the needed rally. MOUNTAIN ROUTE pressed the pace three deep on the backstretch and most of the turn, stalked into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S CANDY CAT broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground to no avail. ROLLINS broke slowly, settled off the rail and was not a threat. JELLYFISH LAKE also broke slowly, split rivals midway on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.
