**Footnotes**

IMAGINE stalked inside then a bit off the rail, advanced three deep into the second turn, took the lead outside a rival, inched away, drifted out in the stretch but held gamely under urging. ROCKELLA chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, angled to the inside in midstretch and went willingly to the wire. EASY OBSESSION chased inside then off the rail, continued outside a rival on the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. ROLLERSKATES settled off the pace outside a rival, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AUNT PINK between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail and weakened in the stretch. LUPITA'SLUCKYANGEL chased three deep then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. SPECIAL HEATHER took the early lead and angled to the inside in the stretch the first time, set the pace along the inside, dueled briefly inside the winner into the second turn, stalked that one on that bend and also weakened. FORTUNATE EVENT saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and failed to menace. MEMORETTE stalked the pace outside then off the rail, angled to the inside nearing the first turn, saved ground tracking the leader, dropped back leaving the second turn and weakened in the drive.
