Footnotes

SIXCESS dueled three deep between horses on the backstretch then three wide into the turn, took the lead outside a rival into the stretch and won clear under urging. HURRY UP AUSTIN forced the pace four wide between foes then angled in and stalked on the turn, came out in the stretch and held second. FINE FLYER chased a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn, bumped with a rival while three deep into the stretch and just missed the place. STREET BOSS broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then outside a rival, swung out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TALKIN TO MOM ROO had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. TIZTIME angled in and saved ground off the pace, remained inside and did not rally. BLOWOUT prompted the pace five wide, stalked outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. AMERICAN OFFICER dueled between horses then stalked leaving the turn, was bumped between rivals into the stretch and also weakened.
