CONNEMARA chased inside, came out in midstretch, bid between horses to gain the lead under left handed urging in deep stretch and prevailed. MR. SATURDAYNIGHT pulled early, stalked just off the rail or outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, bid outside foes a sixteenth out and continued willingly but could not quite match the winner. RANGER HEARTLEY pulled his way to the early lead outside a rival, set the pace a bit off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, came out a bit into the stretch, fought back inside foes in deep stretch and held third. PICO PICO allowed to settle outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, waited off heels in midstretch, angled in and bid along the fence in deep stretch and was outfinished. DREAM NETTIE stalked just off the inside then between foes midway on the first turn, continued outside a rival on the backstretch, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RUNAWAY BANDIDO pulled early and angled in on the first turn, came off the rail leaving that turn, bid alongside the pacesetter early on the backstretch, continued to stalk just off the fence, was in a bit tight off heels in deep stretch and weakened.
