Footnotes

TOMCOLEE had good early speed and dueled inside, gained a short lead on the turn and held on gamely under urging. CON QUIXOTE dueled three deep then outside the winner throughout and continued willingly but could not quite match that one late. FLYING FUGITIVE chased between horses then inside on the turn, came off the rail in midstretch and edged a rival for third. GOOD COP BAD COP had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail and outside a rival on the turn, drifted out in the stretch and was edged for the show. ARCHIE'S DREAM stalked three deep on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, drifted inward in the lane and did not rally. ROYAL IRISH three deep early, settled off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and failed to menace. BIG HORN TOM stalked inside, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
