DINNER MAGIC had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away into the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under some urging and a strong hand ride. CINDAGO five wide early, pressed the pace four wide then stalked outside, came three deep into the stretch, lugged inward through the drive but was clearly second best. REFINERY stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and bested the others. SYDNEY AGAIN angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and improved position. TOMCAT TANGO off a bit slowly, angled in outside a rival on the backstretch, found the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. WILBURS MR. ED sent between horses to duel for the lead, stalked between foes into and on the turn, steadied when squeezed into the stretch and weakened. HIT IT SKIP broke slowly, settled inside, swung out into the stretch and failed to menace. MR. KATZ dropped back off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, swung wide into the stretch and did not rally. KING FOR A DAY steadied in tight between foes early, chased off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. WISDOM CAT chased off the rail then angled in, saved ground on the turn and could not offer the needed response. TENGA CAT had speed between horses then dropped back off the rail on the backstretch and weakened. TIMBER TIME between foes early,stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of WILBURS MR. ED against the second and third finishers for alleged interference into the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to establish blame for the incident.
