EL ADELANTADO chased off the rail, came outside a rival into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch, was bumped in midstretch but rallied under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. OSCAR THE MAYOR chased between horses then toward the inside, came out some in the stretch, bumped with a rival while splitting foes in midstretch and rallied between horses for the place. ASAY CREEK fractious in the gate, sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came off the rail in the stretch, held on well to deep stretch and just saved the show. BEV'S EX chased three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, was bumped in midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award. NAUTICAL RULE stalked off the rail on the backstretch and turn, was between foes past midstretch and weakened. EDDIE THE HAT settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PRACTICAL MAGIC went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and weakened. RECKLESS CAPOTE broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat.
