MOSCOW BURNING took the early lead a bit off the rail, angled in nearing the clubhouse turn, set all the pace inside, turned back bids on the second turn to inch away again and held on gamely under some urging. DANCING GENERAL stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid between foes on the backstretch, continued just off the inside on the second turn and into the stretch and was second best. FORTUNATE EVENT stalked outside a rival, was between horses into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and edged a foe for third. DEL MAR TICKET pulled early, chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, was four wide in midstretch and could not sustain the bid late. JEWEL OF THE YEAR, tracked the pace along the inside, continued on the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed response. CANDY FACTORY stalked the pace three deep, bid outside foes on the backstretch, drifted out into the stretch, steadied between horses while beginning to weaken in midstretch and dropped back.
