DREAM OF SUMMER stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole, drifted in some but proved best under urging. HOUSE OF FORTUNE chased three deep then outside, continued off the rail on the second turn, drifted in some in upper stretch, came out in midstretch and finished willingly. PROPOSED stalked the early pace off the rail then bid outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, battled between foes in midstretch, lugged in a bit in deep stretch, could not match the top pair but held third. SOMETHINABOUTLAURA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and until midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. ROYAL KLEVEN a bit awkwardly into stride, threw her head and steadied early, chased outside a rival or off the rail and lacked the needed rally. BARTOK'S BLITHE saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. SHOW ME YOUR GLORY settled inside chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and wakened.
