Footnotes

MCCANN'S MOJAVE bobbled slightly at the start, sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, fought back in the drive, drifted out a bit late but held on gamely under urging and inched away again late. DESERT BOOM stalked the pace outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid alongside the winner leaving the second turn and in the stretch but could not match that one late. CHEROOT pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail in the stretch and bested the others. TEXCESS stalked the pace outside, moved up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch but could not sustain his bid in the lane. MR. JOE C unhurried early and angled in on the first turn, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. DEPUTY DOC RENZI tracked the pace outside a rival then between horses on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. CARANO angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail and did not rally. DEVIL BADGETT saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside throughout and weakened.
