Footnotes

QUIET ALL AMERICAN saved ground from the outset, got through along the inside into the stretch, swung out over the heels of GATOR TIGER inside the final furlong then closed fast to be up in the final strides. GATOR TIGER looped rivals five wide to challenge into the stretch, drove clear and dropped to the rail in the furlong grounds then just failed to last. FORTY NINE ACRES made a middle move, bid from between rivals in the final furlong and finished strong to just miss. THREE DEADLY SINS was void of early speed, angled out six wide out of the second turn then lodged a mild rally. THANK U PHILIPPE chased early, bid into the stretch then gave way. DA PLANE set a fast early pace then came up empty. SOLDIER FIELD chased to the second turn then faded. FORESTRY STEEL stopped then was outdistanced. ILLICIT LOVER was no factor then was pulled up. A claim of foul by the rider of FORTY NINE ACES against GATOR TIGER for interference in the stretch was disallowed. The race was hand timed.
