**Footnotes**

TINGWITHASTING broke sharp to gain the early lead, was unchallenged while setting a moderate to quick pace then drew off when called upon out of the second turn and was clearly best. SPECIAL REPORT raced wide into the first turn, attempted to collar the winner out of the turn but was no match for that one while second best. RUNAWAY RIZZI was shuffled back early, made a middle move to the stretch but failed to sustain that rally. DR. KATHY made a mild middle move through the second turn then came up empty. BRACKENBER stalked early, got through inside in the second turn to contention but faded in the drive. WICKLOW VAMP passed tiring rivals. CLEVER TO ME raced evenly. LAU MOR'S GLITTER chased for five furlongs then faltered. QUIET AUTHORITY showed little. HARD TO STOP stopped and was outdistanced.
