FLAMING LIGHT dueled inside from the outset, continued well when headed a furlong out then came on again inside under left hand pressure to narrowly prevail. LAUREL LIGHT dueled between rivals for six furlongs, gained a short lead out of the second turn then also continued gamely through a long drive and just missed. SEA MIST made a three wide middle move to be in striking position after six furlongs but failed to sustain that rally. ALLEY BALL was well placed to the stretch then gave way. CLASSY PLACE dueled three wide for six furlongs then gave way. INDIGO MOON was in tight in the early stages but failed to menace. FOREVER SONIC passed tiring rivals. CHEF'S CHOICE raced evenly. LIVING ON THE LINE chased to the second turn then faded. ALLY'S VALENTINE was unruly at the gate then stopped.
