Footnotes

BUSHMILLS BEST broke sharp to gain the early lead inside, set a moderate pace under good handling, repulsed a bid from GONE PROSPECTING through the furlong grounds then shook clear late under pressure. GONE PROSPECTING chased the winner outside, bid outside that one after six furlongs then dueled past mid stretch before hanging late and saved the place. HARBORAGE was unhurried early, fanned four wide out of the second turn then was gaining down the middle of the track late. FIRST MOVEMENT made an inside middle move, angled outside into the stretch but failed to respond when set down. DERBY passed tiring rivals. DR. ELI raced evenly. DIMELO chased for six furlongs then faded. AIR RIDE LOUIS showed little. WORLD BATTLE was hung wide early then stopped after six furlongs.
