DON TITO stalked the pace outside, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage in upper stretch, inched away under urging and held gamely. SPANIARD close up stalking the pace inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels nearing the sixteenth marker, angled out some and finished well between foes. BEST MON prompted the pace three deep then outside a rival, battled between horses on the turn and into the stretch, continued between foes nearing midstretch and just held third. CLASSICAL SLEW chased off the rail, swung out into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip past the eighth pole and just missed the show. NIKKI'SGOLDENSTEED allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRADY BLUE EYES a bit slow into stride, settled inside, came out off heels around a rival in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. OUR SHORTY pulled a bit between horse early, dueled just off the rail then inside into and on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
