UNZIP ME had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came off the rail and responded when challenged again in the stretch, kicked clear while drifting out some and proved best under urging. WAVELINE chased off the rail then three deep leaving the turn, bid outside the winner in the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong but held second. BONIFACIO chased outside, went three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and just got the show. CZECHERS had speed three deep then angled in leaving the backstretch and stalked inside, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and was edged late for a minor award. REBA IS TOPS saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor share. ALPHA KITTEN settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and could not quite offer the necessary late kick. TERRIFY angled in with speed between horses early, prompted the pace outside the winner, stalked on the turn, was between rivals leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch.
