Footnotes

THE BAT SIGNAL chased inside then came off the rail on the backstretch, continued outside approaching the turn, bid three deep on the bend, took the lead in upper stretch, inched away under urging and proved best. SCOFIELD BARRACKS chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out in the stretch and finished with interest to be second best. LEOTHELION outside a rival early, stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and bested the others. MOONLARK sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the turn and into the stretch, fought back past midstretch and weakened late. EL PITUCON (ARG) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, split horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ZULU KING chased off the rail then three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. INVERNESS CAPE veered out at the start, stalked outside a rival then between foes, bid between rivals on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
