CHAMP PEGASUS settled inside then off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under a couple left handed cracks of the whip and a strong hand ride to gain the lead in late stretch and proved best. WHERE'S THE REMOTE unhurried off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch, swung out into the stretch and closed willingly in the final furlong. BOURBON BAY stalked outside a rival then inside, continued along the rail on the second turn, split rivals past midstretch and finished with interest between foes late. MARLANG took the early lead and set the pace off the rail under a long hold, kicked away a bit off the fence on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn, fought back to deep stretch and was outfinished late for a minor award. FALCON ROCK (IRE) stalked a bit off the rail then inside, moved up just off the fence into the second turn to loom a threat but weakened some in the final furlong. UNUSUAL SUSPECT angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WORTH REPEATING close up stalking the pace inside then a bit off the fence, continued outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) chased three deep then outside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch, angled inward in the drive and also weakened.
