CALIFORNIA SOLDIER stalked inside then a bit off the rail on the second turn, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving that turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held on gamely between foes under urging. ALLEY HONDRO floated out into the first turn, angled in on that turn then pulled some on the backstretch, came out a bit into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch, bid along the fence in deep stretch and continued willingly. VALLEY CAT drifted out a bit into the first turn, chased off the rail, went three deep into and out of the second turn, bid three wide in late stretch and also continued on well to the end. RANGER HEARTLEY chased inside then pulled his way between horses leaving the first turn, stalked outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the second turn and weakened. ROMAN GUITAR had speed three deep then outside a rival, inched away leaving the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, fought back leaving the second turn and into the stretch, steadied as rivals went past nearing the eighth pole and also weakened.
