Footnotes

LIBERIAN FREIGHTER chased off the rail, came out some into the stretch, rallied three deep under urging past midstretch then battled outside the runner-up and got up late. COLGAN'S CHIP dueled inside then was eased back and stalked just off the rail, re-bid alongside TROPIC STORM leaving the second turn, put a head in front nearing midstretch, fought back between horses then inside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. TROPIC STORM pulled his way along to duel outside the runner-up then inched away and angled in on the backstretch, fought back inside leaving the second turn and in the stretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. METEORE came off the rail early and chased outside a rival, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed late kick. VICTOR'S CRY settled inside, came out leaving the second turn and again in upper stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. BLUE CHAGALL (FR) angled in and chased inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive and could not offer the needed rally.
