SMILING TIGER angled in and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front past the eighth pole, inched away a bit in late stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. SUPREME SUMMIT settled inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and closed willingly. E Z'S GENTLEMAN stalked the pace three deep, angled in off the rail into the stretch, came out in the drive and continued on well to edge a rival for the show. COST OF FREEDOM had good early speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and weakened some late. GATO GO WIN was in a good position stalking the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. DANCING IN SILKS broke alertly but outward some then dropped back outside, chased outside rivals or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. NEW BAY stalked the pace between horses, steadied in tight nearing the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and weakened.
