Footnotes

MR TOKYO had speed outside foes then stalked off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid three wide under urging past midstretch, gained the lead late and gamely prevailed. STREAKIN' MOHICAN had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away nearing midstretch and held on well but was edged late. PINAL between horses early, dueled outside the runner-up, had that one slip away briefly in midstretch, re-bid between horses to battle for the lead, was in a bit tight at the wire and bested the others. FORMAT V. bobbled slightly at the start, settled inside, came off the rail in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. GILLIGAN chased outside a rival then between horses on the turn and into the stretch, came out some in the drive and lacked the needed rally. MAYBE YES steadied in tight after the start, drifted out early and settled off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch, also came out some in the drive and did not rally.
