DERRICK DO sped to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch and set the pace inside, kicked clear in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. LICHTENSTEIN stalked three deep to the stretch, came out some in the drive and finished well to just miss. BRUTALLY HANDSOME pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn, angled out into the stretch and bested the others. BLAZING chased outside a rival or between foes, continued outside on the turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BATTLE SCHOOL stalked between horses then inside on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. COURTSIDE ACTION allowed to settle outside then three deep, continued off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. GOOD TO GO prompted the pace outside the winner then stalked off the rail or between horses, continued between foes on the turn, drifted inward in the stretch and weakened. REGAL FEVER broke slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and failed to menace. WARREN'S BIG GOLD sent inside early, saved ground chasing the pace and had little left for the stretch.
