KANAN DUME sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, responded when headed in midstretch, fought back alongside DYNAMIC HOST to regain the advantage, battled between foes under urging in late stretch and held gamely. JOB BOSS chased inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, finished willingly outside foes to just miss. DYNAMIC HOST stalked the pace off the rail, angled in approaching the second turn, bid along the fence in the stretch to put a head in front, could not match the top pair late but held third. NORTH FORK three deep early, pulled his way between horses on the backstretch then stalked outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. NO DREAM four wide into the first turn, settled off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. GOLD STAR STATUS chased three deep then moved up four wide midway on the backstretch, stalked alongside a rival, came out four wide between foes into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
