GOTHAM JUNIOR chased inside, came out into the stretch, bid three deep under hand urging to gain the lead past the eighth pole and drew clear under a long hold late. FIVE A DAY had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front between horses in midstretch, was no match for the winner thereafter but held second. LOGICAL HABIT broke slowly, settled off the rail, went around a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and gained the show late outside foes. SOUVENIR SUMMER chased outside a rival then off the inside, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for a minor award between foes late. GIFTED STUDENT dueled inside, fought back on the turn and until midstretch, then weakened. BENNY'S BENCHMARK stalked three deep then outside a rival into and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. JEFFREY'S GROOVE chased a bit off the rail then angled in approaching the turn, dropped back on the bend and had little left for the stretch.
