Footnotes

DIME went up between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, inched clear on the turn, was mildly hand ridden to widen in the stretch and drew off under a long hold. ULTIMATE QUESTION broke out a bit, stalked the pace between horses on the backstretch and turn, continued just off the rail in the stretch and held second. RIDE CANDY RIDE was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and held third outside foes on the line. CERTAINLY CERTAIN broke inward, pulled his way between horses then chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, split horses in midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award. WISE STUDENT forced in a bit at the start, settled just off the rail then inside on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. DESTINED JOURNEY chased off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. DEL MAR DUDE broke inward and a bit slowly, was sent along inside to stalk the pace and weakened in the stretch.
