Footnotes

REGROUP stalked the pace inside, bid between horses on the second turn to take the lead, inched away in the stretch and won clear under urging. BIG SON OF A GUN four wide into the first turn, chased outside, bid three deep on the second turn, could not match the winner in the stretch but was clearly second best. DOC CAN DANCE a bit slow to begin, settled between horses then chased three deep, continued outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. TAK GAMO sped to the early lead, angled in and kicked clear, set the pace inside, dueled midway on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch and weakened. RENEWING five wide early, chased off the rail then three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRIBAL WISH saved ground off the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. THERESASTORMCOMING three deep on the first turn, chased off the rail, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. WARREN'S A LEGEND had speed outside a rival then stalked between horses or a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and also weakened.
