**Footnotes**

PREMIER PEGASUS a step slow into stride, went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back just off the rail in the stretch, inched away under urging past midstretch and held on gamely. MCKENZIES WAY between foes early, dueled outside the winner, fought back past midstretch, could not match that one late but held second. CLUBHOUSE RIDE between horses early, chased off the rail, pulled his way between foes and was in tight midway on the turn, angled inward in upper stretch, came out off heels for room in midstretch and finished willingly. CELESTIC NIGHT between rivals early, pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, waited a bit into the turn, also was in tight along the fence midway on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and was outfinished. AWESOME PATRIOT stalked between horses or outside a rival, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ROAD READY chased outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response in the drive. WINNING DESIRE broke alertly then settled off the pace outside, angled in off the rail on the turn and did not rally.
