Footnotes

OUR BELLINI BIKINI saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn, angled out some into the stretch, bid three deep under urging past the eighth pole, gained the advantage a sixteenth out and proved best. CANDY'S PLEASURE had speed between horses then dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and edged her pace foe for the place. BUTCH MARINO four wide early, angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, put a head in front on the turn, battled alongside that rival in the stretch and between foes a sixteenth out and was edged for second. ULTRA AWESOME between horses early, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DISH THE DIRT saved ground off the pace, came out in midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. SMALL BUT MIGHTY three deep early, chased off the rail, angled in some on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response.
