MR. MONKEY JONES was in a good position chasing the pace along the inside, rallied under urging along the rail in the final furlong, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth marker and proved best. YES IT'S A CAT stalked the leader outside a rival on the backstretch and most of the turn, bid three deep past midstretch, could not quite match the winner late but was second best. BIG BAD LEROYBROWN settled inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. PROUD CARDENAL chased alongside a rival on the backstretch and into the turn, continued off the fence leaving the turn and could not offer the necessary response in the stretch. SEA OF PLEASURE sped to the early lead, kicked clear and set the pace off the rail, angled in some for the turn, shortened stride some in the stretch, was between foes a sixteenth out and weakened. ISLAND RUN threw his head a bit just after the start, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some in the stretch and did not rally.
