Footnotes

FORTY PACES stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the turn, swung out into the stretch, bid three deep in midstretch, gained the lead, inched away under urging and held gamely. SWEET CONSOLIDATOR in a good position stalking the pace outside the winner, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. CHATURUNGA four wide early, dropped back a bit off the rail, moved up some inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch, split horses past midstretch and picked up the show. THE ZAPANA chased three deep then off the rail on the turn, came out some into the stretch and bested the others. REAL ROCKPORT between rivals early, dueled inside, took a short lead in the stretch, fought back past midstretch, then weakened. ONION RING had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, battled between horses in midstretch, then also weakened. TIMETOBEGONE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, dropped back outside a rival on the turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
